**4. Remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy.**

Luke 4:16 "And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read."

Mark 2:27 "And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:"

Mark 16:1 "And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him."

**6. Thou shalt not kill.**
